**Academic Collaboration Agreement between
City University of Hong Kong,
Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China
and
K.I. Satbayev Kazakh National Research Technical University,
the Republic of Kazakhstan**

This academic collaboration agreement (the "**Agreement**") is entered into between the City University of Hong Kong ("**CityUHK**") at 83 Tat Chee Avenue, Kowloon, Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China ("**Hong Kong**") and the K.I. Satbayev University Kazakh National Research Technical University ("**Satbayev University**") at 22a, Satbayev Street, 050013, Almaty, Republic of Kazakhstan, in relation to the academic collaboration via a Joint Bachelor's Degree Programme. To further develop the cooperative relationship among the institutions, both institutions now wish to enter into this Agreement to govern the implementation of the Joint Bachelor's Degree Programme pursuant to the terms and conditions herein.

I. Purpose

1.1 CityUHK and Satbayev University will offer a Two-certificate Joint Bachelor's Degree Programme (the "**Joint-Degree Programme**" or "**Programme**") where students can earn two bachelor's degrees in the Joint-Degree Programme upon successful completion of the curriculum requirements of the respective programmes offered by CityUHK and Satbayev University.

1.2 Students will complete both degrees within four years. Students will pursue an academic programme that begins at Satbayev University and will continue to study the corresponding programme at CityUHK.

1.3 The Joint-Degree Programme opens to students from academic departments of Satbayev University identified in Appendix I to this Agreement. The Joint-Degree Programme will continue to seek out the most academically talented, committed students who wish to pursue and achieve academic excellence in a dual curriculum. The Joint-Degree Programme strives to ensure an enriched academic and social experience in both Kazakhstan and HKSAR for its students and to create an environment that fosters active, innovative learning.

II. General Conditions

II.1 Enrolment

Up to one hundred (100) students, selected by CityUHK from the academic departments concerned at Satbayev University will be enrolled in the Joint-Degree Programme. The first cohort of students will commence their studies at CityUHK in September 2026.

II.2 Tuition and Fees

II.2.1 Students accepted into the Joint-Degree Programme pay their regular tuition and fees to the institution in which they are enrolled: to Satbayev University during their first two years and from Satbayev University to CityUHK during their last two years in accordance with clause VI.1 below. Non-local students need to pay non-local student tuition fee at CityUHK. Subject to clause VI.1 below, students permitted to remain enrolled beyond the expected two years at each institution will continue to pay tuition and fees directly to the institution in which they are enrolled. The institution at which the student is enrolled will be responsible for disclosing to the student any additional costs of attendance. The detailed conditions applicable to specific categories of students may be further specified in a separate addendum to this Agreement, to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

II.2.2 Students shall be responsible for arranging any necessary visa and for covering the cost of accommodation, all travel expenses, books, equipment, insurance (including health insurance) and other incidental expenses. CityUHK will support students in preparation of documents necessary to acquire a valid visa for study in Hong Kong. Nonetheless, it is the students' responsibility to apply for a valid visa and shoulder the fees incurred. CityUHK shall not be liable for the failure on the part of the students to obtain the required documents. During their studies at CityUHK, they will be required to obtain appropriate travel and medical insurance to include medical evacuation and repatriation. It is the responsibility of the students to obtain and maintain insurance coverage throughout the entire period of their study at CityUHK.

II.2.3 Each Satbayev University student enrolled in the Joint-Degree Programme is liable to pay for incidental charges which may be levied by CityUHK from time to time (e.g., sports centre membership, photocopying). Students are responsible for the payment of any fines or other liabilities which they may incur towards CityUHK during the period of their registration with CityUHK (e.g., library, parking, fines).

II.3 Status of Students and Conduct

II.3.1 Students participating in the Joint-Degree Programme, implemented under this Agreement, will be registered at both institutions as undergraduate students in pursuit of the two-certificate joint bachelor's degrees. They will enjoy the same rights and responsibilities as other students at both institutions. It is not anticipated that spouses and dependents will accompany students. Facility access, student services and other privileges of a full-time student will not apply to the student's spouse or dependents.

II.3.2 Satbayev University students enrolled in the Joint-Degree Programme shall abide by all the policies and regulations of CityUHK when studying at CityUHK. In particular, students are subject to the standard procedures and regulations governing attendance, examinations and all

other forms of assessment, personal behaviour and conduct. Students shall also abide all applicable laws in Hong Kong.

II.3.3 Each student is responsible for obtaining the valid visa, passport, and other necessary personal travel documents for study in the other country or territory.

II.4 Academic Advising and Orientation

CityUHK will provide the necessary advice to assist students in integrating into the undergraduate student life of CityUHK during the years they are studying at CityUHK. Students participating in the Joint-Degree Programme will be entitled to take part in the orientation organised for students by CityUHK.

II.5 Housing

Students enrolled in the Joint-Degree Programme will be eligible to apply for student residence managed by CityUHK. Housing at the CityUHK-managed student residence is not guaranteed. Assistance will be provided by CityUHK to locate appropriate accommodation if student residence cannot be provided.

III. Admissions

III.1 Admission to the Satbayev University Component

Acceptance into the Joint-Degree Programme is highly selective. Students have to complete a pre-application for the Joint-Degree Programme by the end of their first year. Applicants must have achieved a minimum cumulative grade-point average (CGPA) required by each programme. Satbayev University will interview all students who submit the pre-application for the Joint-Degree Programme and provide CityUHK with a recommendation list. Appendix II presents the administration timeline.

III.2 Progression to the CityUHK Component of the Joint-Degree Programme

III.2.1 Application instructions and materials will be provided by the Admissions Office of CityUHK. Students' applications are carefully evaluated on the basis of a few criteria, including but not limited to academic performance, high school grades, English proficiency scores, letters of recommendation, a personal statement, commitment to the Joint-Degree Programme, and evidence of commitment to the fields of study offered to students in the Joint-Degree Programme. Normally, CityUHK will interview all students selected as finalists for admission to the Joint-Degree Programme.

III.2.2 CityUHK will have the sole and final authority over which students it will accept and may deny admission to any applicants it deems to be unqualified. In making admissions decisions, both institutions will abide by the principles of non-discrimination and academic freedom to which they are both committed.

III.2.3 Satbayev University students should provide true and valid information and documents in support of the application. Provision of any false or misleading information will lead to disqualification of the application and no fees paid will be refunded.

III.3 Selection of Students

III.3.1 Students will be considered according to their academic merits, but would typically have obtained the following qualifications:

1. A minimum CGPA of 3.33 (for those applying to Department of Materials Science and Engineering / Department of Architecture and Civil Engineering) or 3.30 (for those applying to Department of Computer Science) in the core modules in Year 1 and Year 2 at Satbayev University;
2. Have a good English language proficiency and meet one of the following minimum English language proficiency requirements:
 - a. TOEFL: 79 on the internet-based test or 550 on the paper-based test
 - b. IELTS: overall band score of 6.5;
3. Pass an admission interview and overall assessment conducted by academic staff from the academic departments concerned, where applicable; and
4. Meet all the admission requirements of CityUHK including specific programme admission requirements. Recommended Satbayev University students are required to have achieved a minimum score of 65 for Materials Science, 75 for Civil Engineering and 85 for Computer Science in Unified National Test (University Entrance Exam). These minimum score requirements under this clause III.3.1.4 are subject to changes, as they may vary each academic year, and the final requirements will be determined during the admission period.

III.3.2 Exceptional arrangement of English proficiency requirements will apply to the first cohort of students who will commence their studies at CityUHK in September 2026 only. Under this exceptional arrangement, students will take either the TOEFL or IELTS test and meet the English language requirements as outlined in clause III.3.1.2 prior to admission or within 12 months of admission to CityUHK. Failure to meet the English language requirements will result in the students being ineligible to graduate, regardless of their academic performance during their studies in the Joint-Degree Programme.

IV. Curriculum and Degree

IV.1 Student Eligibility and Available Majors

Students who have completed the first year of study in participating institutes, departments, and majors at Satbayev University as agreed upon by both institutions are eligible to apply to CityUHK for admission to the Joint-Degree Programme, subject to the standards set forth in this Agreement. A list of participating institutes, departments, and approved majors is in Appendix I. Additional majors can be added to Appendix I upon mutual review and agreement in writing by both institutions without further modification of this Agreement.

IV.2 Credits

IV.2.1 Students at Satbayev University should have completed the minimum number of credits for the respective programmes as required by Satbayev University before studying at CityUHK. Students admitted to the Joint-Degree Programme will then move to Hong Kong and begin the CityUHK portion of the Joint-Degree Programme at the beginning of their third year. Students in the Joint-Degree Programme must complete the minimum number of credits for the respective programmes as required by CityUHK, in addition to the credit units earned at Satbayev University, to earn a BEng/BSc degree from CityUHK.

IV.2.2 The transfer of credits from Satbayev University toward fulfillment of major or concentration requirements at CityUHK shall be subject to a formal evaluation process and is not automatic. Credits will only be transferred upon verification of curriculum alignment and subject to the approval of the respective academic department following an annual review of all relevant course materials and syllabi. The number of transferable credits and their corresponding course equivalencies shall be determined in accordance with the departmental requirements at both universities. The rule of grade conversation is specified in Appendix III.

IV.2.3 Each institution will maintain full and complete records relating to the Programme and student performance, and shall grant the other institution access to such records as appropriate to fulfill this Agreement, in accordance with applicable laws and policies of each institution. Each institution shall arrange for appropriate consents from its enrolled students as needed to enable the sharing of transcripts and other information between the institutions as may be required for the fulfillment of this Agreement and as otherwise required by law.

IV.3 Degree Requirements

IV.3.1 Students successfully completing the requirements of the Programme will be awarded two degrees: a Bachelor degree at CityUHK and a Bachelor degree at Satbayev University. A sample of certificate is attached in Appendix IV.

IV.3.2 In order for students to graduate from the Joint-Degree Programme, students need to complete all requirements of both participating institutions, Satbayev University and CityUHK. Failure to satisfy all requirements of both institutions as articulated in this Agreement may result in a delay in the graduation date at one or both institutions, and/or the student's removal from the Joint-Degree Programme.

IV.3.3 Failure to make progress towards either degree programme during enrolment in the Joint-Degree Programme may result in the removal of the student from the Joint-Degree Programme.

IV.4 Conduct & Registration

IV.4.1 Each Satbayev University student enrolled at CityUHK shall abide by all the policies and regulations of CityUHK when studying at CityUHK. In particular, students are subject to the standard procedures and regulations governing attendance, examination and all other forms of assessment, personal behaviour and conduct. Students shall also abide by the laws in Hong Kong.

IV.4.2 Satbayev University students will have the same benefit of CityUHK student services (whether academic, administrative, or pastoral and welfare support) and facilities (such as student

support services, dining, library and computer service usage, sports and students organisations) as other regular CityUHK undergraduate students for the duration of their period of enrolment upon payment of the tuition and fees to CityUHK.

IV.4.3 Satbayev University students will not be eligible for participating in regular semester exchange programmes during the study period at CityUHK.

V. Management and Service

V.1 Each participating department from each institution shall designate one individual to fulfil the responsibility of Joint-Degree Programme candidate coordinator to facilitate information exchanges and performance under the terms of this Agreement. A list of the designated coordinators under this Agreement is provided below:

V.2 The CityUHK coordinators in the department concerned will exchange all relevant information about the available majors offered at their department and students' academic progress with the coordinator at Satbayev University as appropriate.

V.3 CityUHK shall maintain records of Satbayev University students with the same personal and academic information tracking as for regularly enrolled students. Each institution is responsible for taking the appropriate internal measures to protect the confidentiality and privacy of personally-identifiable academic and financial aid information in compliance with applicable laws and regulations in its jurisdiction, and its internal rules and regulations. Satbayev University is responsible for obtaining all appropriate consents from applicants and students to enable conveying all information contemplated by this Agreement to CityUHK (and from CityUHK) in accordance with applicable laws of Hong Kong.

V.4 CityUHK shall provide pre-departure information to each incoming Satbayev University student, and organise an orientation programme for the students upon their arrival.

V.5 Each institution agrees that, in connection with the nomination, evaluation and admission of students to the aforesaid programmes, such institution shall not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, ethnicity, colour, religion, sex, sexual orientation, marital or parental status, national origin, age or disability.

V.6 CityUHK agrees to take reasonable measures to provide appropriate assistance to incoming Satbayev University students who, at the time of application to the aforesaid Joint-Degree Programme, have declared any special needs.

V.7 CityUHK reserves the right to terminate a student's participation in the Joint-Degree Programme if, following a formal review process conducted in accordance with CityUHK's disciplinary regulations and policies, the student is found to have engaged in conduct that violates such regulations or is demonstrably detrimental to the Programme's operation or reputation. Any such decision shall be communicated in writing to Satbayev University, with a copy to the student concerned, and shall take effect immediately upon issuance. In such cases, tuition and fees paid shall not be refunded, and the student shall bear all costs related to transportation and repatriation.

VI. Financial Arrangement

VI.1 Payment Schedule

VI.1.1 Satbayev University acknowledges receipt of funds (the "Funds") from the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan, and it shall pay CityUHK the non-local undergraduate student tuition fee for two years for each student enrolled in the Joint-Degree Programme at CityUHK with the said Funds. The international student tuition fee varies each year and will be based on CityUHK's rate for the year of admission at Satbayev University¹.

VI.1.2 The tuition fee payments shall be made in eight equal instalments of one-eighth of the total payment each. Tuition fee adjustments for changes in student numbers or other circumstances will be reflected in the next payment.

VI.1.3 Each payment shall be paid in September and January of each academic year when the Joint-Degree Programme starts. One exception is the first payment, which covers the initial two instalments for Cohort 2024.

VI.2 Payment Procedure

VI.2.1 Satbayev University shall make the tuition fee payments to CityUHK using a method mutually agreed by both institutions in writing.

VI.2.2 Satbayev University shall provide CityUHK with the payment details, including the transaction reference number, at least five (5) business days before the due date. CityUHK will issue official receipts to Satbayev University after the funds have been received.

VI.2.3 All tuition fees shall be made in Hong Kong Dollars (HKD). All payments shall be made free and clear of any deduction. Any exchange difference and bank charges arising from the payment will be solely borne by Satbayev University.

VI.3 Late Payments

VI.3.1 In case of payment delay, both institutions will resolve the matter through amicable communication and coordination.

VI.3.2 Notwithstanding the aforesaid, CityUHK reserves the right to suspend the enrolment of students or withhold the provision of academic services if any tuition fee payment is more than three (3) months overdue.

VI.4 Financial Reporting and Audits

VI.4.1 Each institution shall bear their respective taxes and fees.

VI.4.2. CityUHK will issue a document *Act of Completed Payment* once CityUHK receives the payment from Satbayev University.

VI.5. Programme Expansion and Adjustment of Fees

VI.5.1 If the institutions agree to expand the Joint-Degree Programme by increasing the number of student enrolments, the institutions shall review and adjust the tuition fee accordingly.

VI.5.2 Any changes to the tuition fee shall be mutually agreed by both institutions and documented in a written amendment to this Agreement.

VI.5.3 If a student withdraws from CityUHK prematurely, the tuition fees and other charges already paid will not be refunded. However, if there are special and reasonable circumstances, Satbayev University must submit a written application. CityUHK reserves the right to decide, at its discretion, whether to refund all or part of the tuition fees and charges.

VI.5.4 According to the regulation at CityUHK, students are required to pay a graduation fee. If a student wishes to take a leave of absence (the leave must be in terms of semesters and cannot exceed 4 semesters, with the maximum duration of the Programme not exceeding 5 years), they may apply through the CityUHK website. Additionally, the student is required to pay a continuation fee of HKD 1,500 per semester to maintain active enrolment.

VII. Implementation of the Agreement

VII.1 Neither institution shall make any public announcement or press release regarding the existence or contents of this Agreement or otherwise use the name, insignia or symbols of the other, for any purpose whatsoever, without the prior written consent of the other institution. Nothing in this Agreement will establish an exclusive relationship between the institutions. Neither institution will assign, delegate, or subcontract this Agreement to any third party without the prior written consent of the other institution, and any attempt to do so without such consent shall be void.

VII.2 Anti-bribery and other compliance: Each institution agrees that in connection with this Agreement, it will comply with applicable anti-bribery and anti-corruption laws and regulations of Hong Kong and the Republic of Kazakhstan. Each institution further agrees that it will not offer, promise, or provide (or authorise the offer, promise, or provision of), directly or indirectly, anything of value to any government official, political party official, political candidate, or employee thereof, or to any other third party, for the purpose of obtaining or retaining business or obtaining any illegal benefit or advantage. Each institution agrees to comply with other applicable laws in the performance of this Agreement.

VII.3 Notwithstanding the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Ordinance (Chapter 623 of the Laws of Hong Kong) or any other similar laws or regulations, no one other than a party to this Agreement will have any right to enforce any of the terms in this Agreement. There are no third-party beneficiaries to this Agreement. Without limitation, no student is an intended third-party beneficiary to this Agreement.

VII.4 Each institution will be subject to the laws and regulations of its own jurisdiction and its internal policies. On reasonable notice and at reasonable times, each institution (or its auditor or other representative) will be granted access to pertinent records maintained by the other, as may be necessary for the institution to comply with its legal or institutional obligations.

VIII. Governing Law and Duration of the Agreement

VIII.1 Both institutions shall use good faith efforts to resolve any dispute or claim arising out or in relation with this Agreement amicably. If the dispute or claim cannot be resolved by amicable negotiations within [28] days, then the institutions agree that (a) all claims or actions, related to, or arising out of this Agreement against Satbayev University or its employees or agents shall be brought only in the courts in the Republic of Kazakhstan, and (b) all claims or actions, related to, or arising out of this Agreement against CityUHK or its employees or agents shall be brought only in the courts of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China. This Agreement shall be governed and construed under the laws of the location of the sitting court, without regard to principles of conflicts of law.

VIII.2 This Agreement will be made in a set of TWO (2). Each institution will keep one copy.

VIII.3 The Agreement shall take effect after being dually signed and will remain in force for FIVE (5) years from the last date of signing unless and until terminated by either institution with SIX (6) months' prior notice in writing.

VIII.4 Both institutions shall discuss and decide on the continuation or revision of the Agreement six (6) months prior to its expiration.

VIII.5 Any institution may immediately terminate this Agreement by giving the other institution a written notice if it determines that its continued performance of this Agreement would violate any laws, regulations, policies, or rules applicable to such institution, jeopardize the health or safety of its faculty, students, or staff, or adversely affect its accreditation, licenses, or tax status. This Agreement may only be amended by a written agreement between Satbayev University and CityUHK.

VIII.6 Upon termination pursuant to this clause VIII, students already studying in or admitted to the Joint-Degree Programme will be allowed to complete their studies at CityUHK under the terms of the Agreement in effect at the time of their acceptance into the Joint-Degree Programme and Satbayev University shall continue to pay the relevant tuition fees for those students.

Appendix I: Majors and Concentrations

The Joint Bachelor's Degree Programme ("the Joint-Degree Programme") allows students to spend four years examining a specific area of study from two different, international perspectives. The major that students choose to follow in years one and two at Satbayev University will carry over to their time at City University of Hong Kong, and courses within the approved majors are evaluated by both institutions to help with the academic planning process in years three and four of the Joint-Degree Programme. Students within the undergraduate colleges at Satbayev University must be following one of the majors listed below in order to be eligible to apply for admission to the Joint-Degree Programme.

Appendix III: Credit Transfers and Conversion of Grades

1. Conversion of Academic Credit Units

Credits from Satbayev University do not automatically transfer toward the CityUHK major or concentration. Transfer of credits toward the major/concentration is accepted at the respective department's discretion based on annual review of all necessary course syllabi. The amount of transferable credits and course mapping would vary by programmes and will be referred to each department's requirements.
