The peer-reviewed educational program of the master's program "Geology and exploration of a mineral deposit" is developed in accordance with the Law on Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the State Program for Industrial and Innovative Development of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the State Educational Standard of the Master's Program of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the National Qualification Framework, professional standards and is consistent with the Dublin descriptors and the European Qualification Framework .

The content of the educational program is aimed at training highly qualified, competitive specialists in the field of geology, prospecting and exploration of mineral deposits for geological enterprises engaged in subsoil use at all stages of exploration and production, research and design institutions, universities and state supervision bodies for rational use and protection subsoil that meets the requirements of the modern market and international standards.

The program meets the basic requirements of the standard. Its structure includes a cycle of basic disciplines (10 credits), a cycle of major disciplines (25 credits), which is 35 credits for theoretical training. The share of the experimental research work of the undergraduate, including the internship and the implementation of the master's project, accounts for 13 credits.

The program under review includes: competencies of a graduate of the educational program of the master's program, formed as a result of mastering the master's program; documents regulating the content and organization of the educational process in the implementation of the master's program. The educational program regulates the goals, expected results, the content of the educational process, the assessment of the quality of the graduate's training in this area of training. The disciplines of the curriculum for the peer-reviewed educational program form the entire necessary list of general cultural and professional competencies provided for by the State Program of Industrial and Innovative Development of the Republic of Kazakhstan. The structure of the curriculum is generally logical and consistent. The content of the disciplines corresponds to the competence of the graduate model.

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
